

COUNTDOWN

12 -10 months

- Set a budget. Factor in the number of guests and determine how much you can afford to spend.
- Decide on a place. Consider your wedding style and choose a first, second and third choice. Factor in travel time and distance.
- Research the resorts and select which one is ideal for you and your loved ones. Each property has its own personality!
- Research airfare rates.
- Look into the marriage legalities
- Notify family and friends of your decision to marry away; set a date.
- Decide on your wedding attendants.
- After selecting a resort, make travel arrangements for a visit.
- Discuss with your wedding coordinator what you envision for color theme, florals, video, lighting, photography and more.

9 months

- Visit the resort and meet with the on-site wedding coordinator and local vendors. Look into a group discount on room rates.
- Begin your search for your honeymoon resort if you will not be honeymooning at your wedding resort.
- Start gown shopping and begin registering for gifts.
- Put together your guest list.
- Set up your wedding website. Start with your wedding date and location, adding travel info and other relevant logistics as you go.

6 months

- Send out save-the-dates to give your guests plenty of time to make travel arrangements.
- Get a rough head count; reserve a block of rooms.
- Contact your officiant. For most religious ceremonies, you may be required to attend pre-wedding counseling. Civil ceremonies require additional paperwork. Work with your wedding coordinator to guide you step by step.
- Prepare all paperwork (passports, documents needed for marriage application and license).
- Make sure website is updated with your most recent information
- Review documentation for a legal ceremony with your coordinator. Research group activites and excursions. Prepare welcome letter to guests and itinerary of events to include in gift bag.



- Review and finalize contracts.
- Buy travel and wedding insurance.
- Reserve a block of rooms at the hotel in different price ranges and direct your invitees to your wedding website for the details.
- Contact a travel agent to see if you can reserve a block of seats with an airline. Many carriers offer discounts to passengers with groups over ten.
- Book your honeymoon/travel plans.
- Select and order your gown and bridesmaid dresses.
- Make final selections for your flowers, decor, menu and cake.
- Select music for the ceremony, cocktail hour and reception.
- Make arrangements for any transportation at the location such as a shuttle for quests to and from the airport.

4 months

- Send out invitations.
- Have groom and groomsmen rent tuxedos, if wearing them.



3 months

- Make sure website is updated with your most recent information.
- Review documentation for a legal ceremony with your coordinator. Research group activites and excursions. Prepare welcome letter to quests and itinerary of events to include in gift bag.
- Order brochures of local attractions and area maps to include in the gift bag.

2 months

- Set up a seating chart, get all RSVPs from guests.
- Test a spray tan if you plan on getting one for the wedding.

3-6 weeks

- Confirm travel reservations; release any rooms not needed.
- Finalize details with wedding coordinator and local vendors.
- Review an order of events schedule with your coordinator.
- Revisit ceremony details: write vows, finalize music.
- Ask quests to RSVP for group activities via e-mail.
- Ship gift bag items, printed materials (programs, etc.) to site.

2 weeks

- Finalize guest head count and confirm group activities.
- Update your website with final itinerary.
- Confirm your honeymoon reservation and any special requests.
- Address any wedding announcements, stamp and arrange for mailing on your wedding day.

1 week

- Finalize the seating plan; give caterer your final guest list
- Pack what you need for the wedding and honeymoon; pick up tuxes
- Put together an emergency kit (spot remover, band-aids, aspirin, etc.).
- Determine photo schedule and shot list for photographer.
- Confirm final meeting with vendors for when you arrive.

Day before departure

- Go over final details with coordinator; update website.
- Contact wedding party and make sure they know how to reach you.

3-4 days

 Arrive at location and meet with on-site coordinator, officiant and vendors to review final details.



DOCUMENTS REQUIRED FOR

CIVIL/LEGAL CEREMONIES



The Bride & Groom must NOT be legally married in order to qualify for our civil ceremony. If they are already married, they must choose a Symbolic or Vow Renewal ceremony. Bride & Groom must arrive three (3) business days prior to ceremony (Monday – Friday) and four (4) if going to Cozumel. Couple must arrive by noon or earlier in order to consider day of arrival as the first business day.

One month and fifteen (15) days before your wedding date please submit via email to your wedding coordinator:

- 1. Copy of Birth Certificates (certified copy of each one) to be translated into Spanish at the resort. If not in Spanish, the name that appears on your wedding certificate will be the same as on your passport. If you would like the name of your parents to appear on the marriage certificate, it must have an Apostille (http://www.hcch.net/index_en.php?act=text.display&tid=160). Otherwise, their name will not be included on the certificate.
- 2. Copy of your valid passport
- 3. If divorced, a certified copy of divorce decree in Spanish with Apostille is required. If divorced more than once, please bring each divorce decree in Spanish with Apostille.
- 4. Legal documentation of adoption or name change (if applicable)*
- 5. Certified copy of former spouse's Death Certificate (if applicable)* Upon your arrival:
- 6. Home address and occupations (Bride & Groom)
- 7. Valid passport
- 8. Tourist ID Card (provided by customs upon your arrival at Cancun International Airport). Please be sure to complete all information correctly on Tourist ID, otherwise you may need to obtain a new Tourist ID at the airport. Names on

Tourist ID, Divorce Decree, birth certificates and passport MUST be the same. Please be advised that the Civil Registry department will take the exact names reflected on the Bride and Groom's passport to generate the marriage certificate.

- 9. Blood test (to determine blood type, H.I.V. and S.T.D.). Tests must be taken at the resort and results are ready within
- 24 hours. (Fee of approx. \$50.00 USD per person and \$84.00 USD per person for Isla Mujeres is included in the administrative /government fee.) If test is positive, a special release must be signed by couple in order to proceed with the ceremony. (Does not apply to Playacar, Cozumel and Isla Mujeres; if test is positive wedding cannot be performed.) Results will be delivered directly to the Justice of the Peace office.
- 10. If divorced less than one year, a mandatory pregnancy test must be taken at the resort (approx. \$15.00 USD fee). If test is positive, wedding cannot be performed.
- 11. Four (4) witnesses and their details: name, age, nationality, home address, occupation, passport and Tourist ID.

Witnesses must arrive three (3) business days prior to ceremony (Monday - Friday) and four (4) if going to Cozumel.

Witnesses must be 18 years or older. If witnesses are not available, Palace Resorts will provide them at no additional cost.

IMPORTANT NOTE: If the Bride or Groom's nationality is Mexican, additional documents are required. Please advise your Wedding Coordinator at least 3 months in advance. Names on Tourist ID, Divorce Decree and Passport MUST be the same, including spelling. Mexican registry office is open from Monday through Friday only – no civil ceremonies can be performed on Sundays.

Please note that Birth Certificates, Divorce Decrees, Death Certificates, Adoption and Name Change documents become the property of the State of Quintana Roo, Mexico. A Marriage Certificate is provided by the State of Quintana Roo, Mexico for civil ceremonies. This is a legal document issued in Spanish. All wedding couples must contact their local court house for filing requirements. Every state/country is different when it comes to filing of foreign marriage documents. Some states/countries require the certificates to be translated from Spanish to English while others may require additional paperwork to be filed. This is the couples' responsibility and Palace Resorts is not liable for any additional charges that may be associated with the state/country's requirements for supplementary paperwork. Ceremony cannot be performed unless all documents are in order (NO EX-CEPTIONS). All documents with the exception of passports become the property of the State of Quintana Roo, Mexico. Documents are accepted in English or Spanish; please notify your Palace Resorts Certified Wedding Coordinator otherwise to discuss translation. Additional paperwork will apply. Cost may vary depending on number of pages per document.

DOCUMENTS REQUIRED FOR SYMBOLIC OR VOW RENEWAL CEREMONIES

Symbolic weddings are not legally binding ceremonies. It is the responsibility of the couple to arrange a legal marriage in their home town whether it's pre/post travel. Bride & Groom must arrive two (2) business days prior to ceremony (Monday – Friday) and three (3) if going to Cozumel. Couple must arrive by noon or earlier in order to consider day of arrival as the first business day.

Upon your arrival:

- 1. Valid passport
- 2. Tourist ID Card (provided by customs upon your arrival at Cancun International Airport)

WEDDING INFORMATION

- Administrative / Government fees of \$460.00 USD* will be applied to all civil ceremonies performed by a Justice of the Peace in addition to package cost. Translation fees for documents will be charged at the resort according to documents and number of pages.
- In case of inclement weather, fireworks presentation will not be provided. No credits will apply.
- Same-sex weddings are strictly available at our adults/couples (18+) only resorts.
- If you wish to work with a wedding planner other than a Palace Wedding Coordinator, you will be required to assign him/her as "primary contact" to your account handled with your Palace Resorts Wedding Coordinator. All matters will go through him/her.
- Dress Code: Formal or semi-formal, no shorts or bathing suits. Groom may wear dressy shorts for ceremony only. For selected restaurants, formal dress code applies.
- Wedding passes are valid until 11:00 pm and guests with wedding passes must exit the resort by 11:00 pm. No exceptions will be made.

PAYMENT POLICIES

To reserve and confirm your wedding date and time, there is a \$250 USD non-refundable deposit. Final payment is due 45 days prior to ceremony. All items will be non-refundable if cancelled 30 days prior to ceremony. Visa, Master Card & American Express also are accepted. Personal checks are not accepted at the resort.
